<p>Welcome & introductions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">We have a new member from USBE – her name is Kim Herrera and she is a counselor in TooeleAction Item: The June 8th meeting should be rescheduled for June 22nd due to conference conflicts
<p>Executive Committee Chair Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">RFP: The RFP has been awarded to Sokanu. It will be a stand-alone system linked to UtahFutures. It will be linked within the next month. Comment: The Advisory Board would like the Sonkanu system to look as much like UF as possible, for example, all of the companies listed on the home page should be removed. Action Item: Max will rollout a strategy for adding Sokanu to UtahFutures.Legislative/Budget: UtahFutures did not receive any money from the legislature this year. As we prepare for the next session, impact data will be needed to demonstrate the systems effectiveness. Steve talked about using FAFSA completion data.Marketing/Training: Talking cards are being developed with the endorsement from the PTA. They plan to distribute 100,000 sets to K-12 families.
