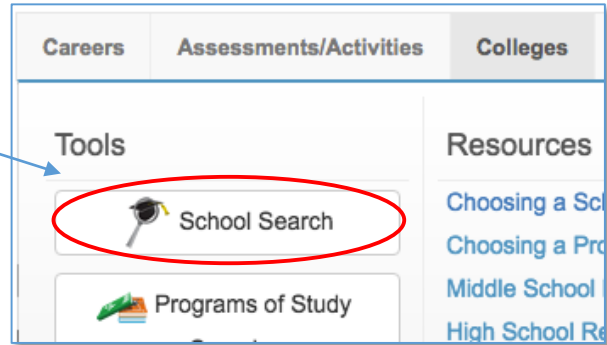

## How to Search for Schools

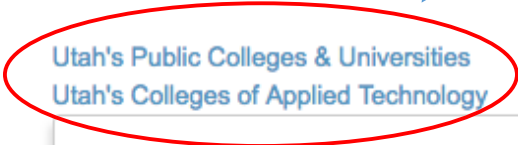
Use the school search tool to find information about colleges and universities.

### Get Started:

1. From the main navigation menu, click **Colleges > School Search**



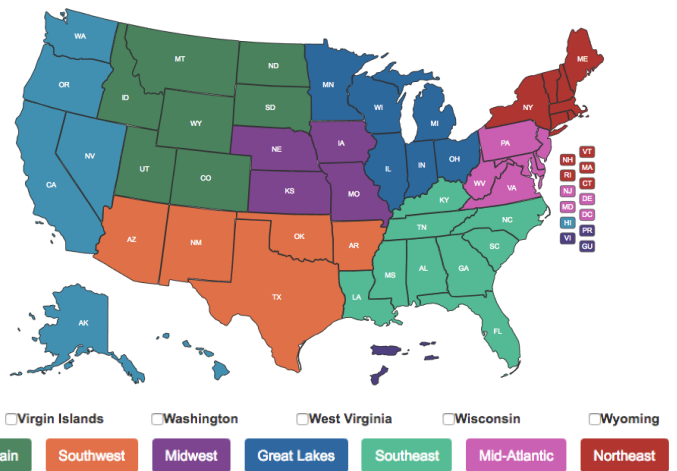
For quick access to Utah's Public Colleges and Universities and Utah's Colleges of Applied Technology, use the hyperlinks

**Keyword Search:** Use if you know the name of the school.

Otherwise, use the search categories to find and filter schools.

*Note: Make sure you clear the search criteria before you start a new search.*



**State filter:** Allows you to search colleges in up to 9 states, or choose by color coded region below the map.

**Programs of Study filter:** Filter schools by which programs they offer.

- Click on the **(+)** sign next to a field to open a list of programs
- Click on the name of a program to add it to your selected programs list.

*Note:* Program names vary by school, so select a few similar programs to ensure you find all of the schools that offer your program

**Search Results:**

- At a glance, basic information about a school is available on the search results page.
- For more detailed information, click on the **School Name**.

- To compare detailed information of schools, click the box next to the school name
